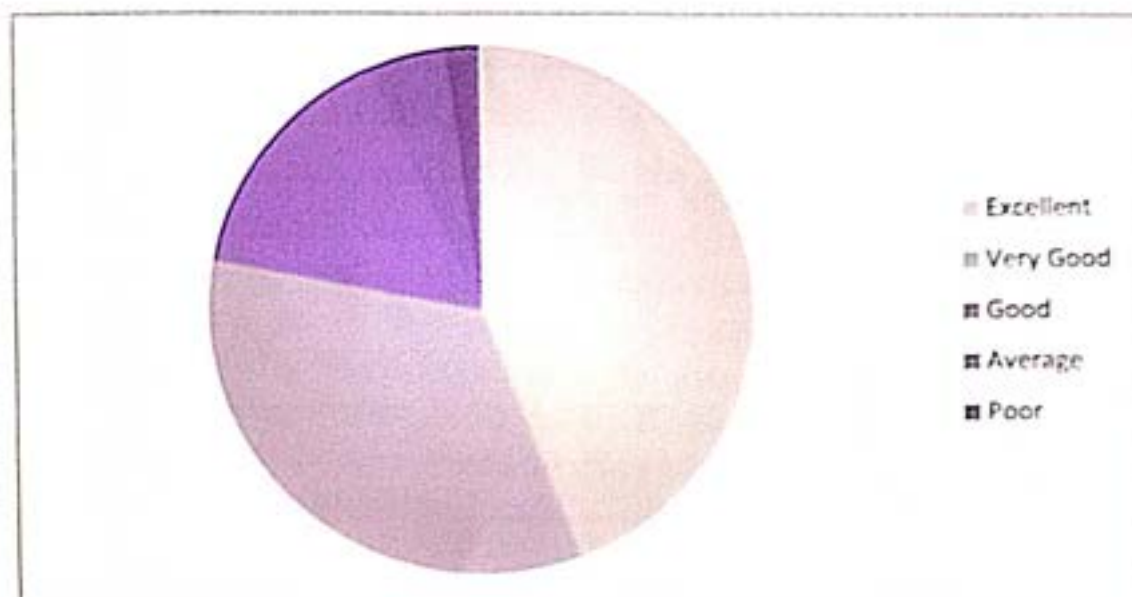

Action taken report based on the feedback received from the Alumni:

2017-2018 :

1. The College Constitutes an Admission Committee every year as per the norms of the university to monitor the entire admission process. Actions were initiated to update our college website by providing the details of various courses and details of the faculty members. Publicity regarding admission is undertaken with the support of Alumni, parents as well as current students. Wide publicity is given through display at various strategic points throughout the district and near by districts.
2. Steps were taken to improvise the interest of students and to take part in various sports and cultural activities. Two Physical Directors (One among them holds Ph.D., Degree in Physical Education) were appointed and functioning well to create games and sports awareness among students. Physical Directors were instructed to enrol the students to take part in various games like Volley ball, kabbadi, boxing, chess, carame, Shuttle cock and other sports activities. Such as Shot put, long jump 100 metres, relay etc., after the college hours (after 2pm)
3. Adequate space is provided to practice all the above said games and sports activities. Incidental expenses are met by the college when students represent the college at the university level.
4. To promote cultural activities, Tamil Department Head and its staff members were assigned to train our students to take part in different Inter collegiate cultural competitions. Management provides adequate fund to meet the incidental expenses during the participants.
5. Steps were taken to improve the pass percentage. At present our students Scores University ranking in their final semester examinations. We plan to support the student to change the existing teaching – learning method and to introduce the new methods like such as experimental learning, participate learning and problem solving methodology for enhancing the quality of the students.

2021-2022:
